Co-curricular activities are events that take place outside the classroom but reinforce or supplement classroom curriculum in some way. They provide complementary learning of some form. Examples of co-curricular activities can include student council, school sports teams, math clubs, chess clubs, talent shows. All of these activities take place outside the traditional classroom setting and are not graded or given any academic credit as in the case of the school curriculum.

Where as co-curricular activities are connected in some way to the school and to academic learning, extracurricular activities step outside the school's realm. Involvement in a sport that happens outside of the school, for example, would be considered an extracurricular activity. Other examples might include church related activities, music classes that are not associated with the school, dance recitals, or martial arts competitions.

Benefits of engaging in extra and co - curriculum activities



Gives a vast choice for pursuing interests
Students are exposed to a variety of activities that also allow them to explore their area of interest. When students participate in extracurricular activities, they are able to discover skills they never thought they could pursue in the first place.



Higher self-esteem
Every student has their own potential and when a student achieves success through the activities he/she is passionate about, their self-confidence improves. For students who show a good inclination towards academic disciplines, co-curricular activities help them feel more confident about their abilities



Adds weightage to the resume
Participating in extra-curricular activities helps students when they are applying for admission to a college/university or even for a job. To include the achievements in extra-curricular activities on a resume works as evidence of the interests and skills of a student. At college levels, these skills can show that students have well-rounded personalities and can contribute to the college's achievements too.



Improves time management
The word extra in extracurricular activities refers to something that is done beyond the space of the usual curriculum. Therefore, students have to spend extra time apart from the school hours to pursue these activities. They learn to prioritize their daily tasks to ensure that both academic and extra-curricular activities are given equal importance. Thus, developing their ability to manage time well.



Enhances academic performance
